OG LESSONS ARE HARD!

- Building "Reading Brain"
- Many of our students are more productive if they get a "Brain Break"
- Students will describe your lessons as "fun" if you build in games
- Games make learning fun and engaging!



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BEST PRACTICES



GAMES ARE GREAT IN OG LESSONS, BUT...

- Games must be intentional and must maintain the fidelity of the OG lesson
 - Review Reading or Spelling, Syllable, Irregular Word Work
- Games cannot be complicated -- Use the "classics"
- Games cannot take too much time -- time is precious!
- Best when they are built into the OG lesson routine



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


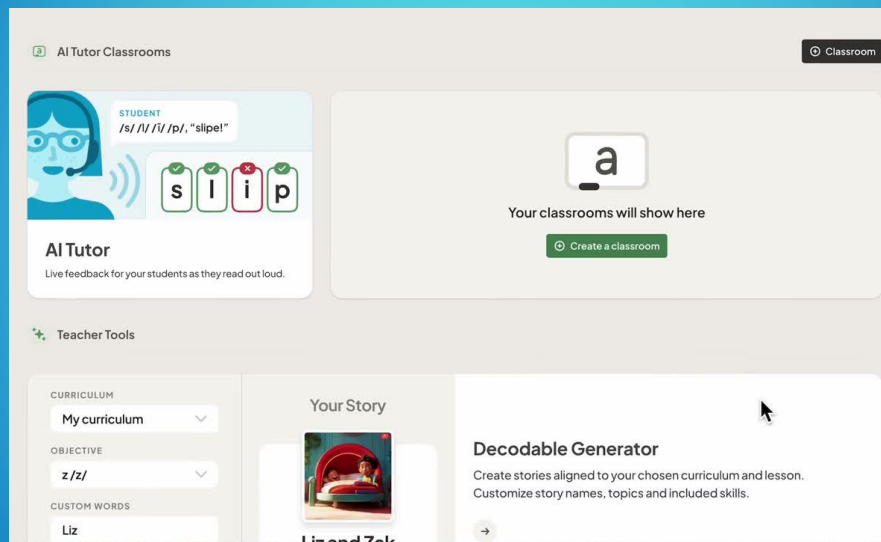

- Be amazed!

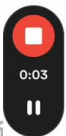
